HARMONY CREATES HAPPINESS

“You will make my JOY COMPLETE by having the same mind, by sharing the same love, by being united in spirit, and intent on one purpose.” Philippians 2:2 (NAS)

HOW TO REDUCE CONFLICT WITH OTHERS

1. NEVER LET PRIDE BE MY GUIDE.

“Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit...” Philippians 2:3a (NIV)

SELFISH AMBITION:

“For wherever there is jealousy and selfish ambition, there you will find disorder and evil of every kind.” James 3:16 (NLT)

VAIN CONCEIT:

“Don’t live to make a good impression on others.” (TLB)

“Don’t do anything from a cheap desire to boast.” (TEV)

2. BE HUMBLE OR I’LL STUMBLE.

“Instead, be humble and give more honor to others than to yourself.” Philippians 2:3b (NCV)

“God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.” James 4:6 (NIV)

3. LISTEN AND PAY ATTENTION.

“Don’t be interested only in your own life, but be interested in what concerns others too.” Philippians 2:4 (NCV)

4. ASK, “_____?”.

“Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus.” Philippians 2:5 (NIV)

ACTING LIKE JESUS MEANS...

A. I DON’T _____.

“Though he was God, he did not demand and cling to his rights as God. He emptied himself of all he had...” Philippians 2:6 (TLB)

B. I LOOK _____.

“Jesus took on the nature of a servant, becoming a human just like us.” Philippians 2:7 (ESV)

C. I DO _____.

“While living as a man, Jesus humbled himself even more, by being fully obedient to God, even when that meant his death on a cross!” Philippians 2:8 (NCV)
